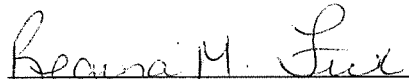
- g. Motion to discuss details of FEMA grant webinar June 14th- R. Fick- Karen to see if there is a recorded video available.

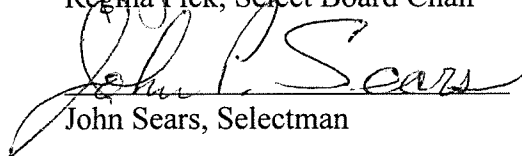

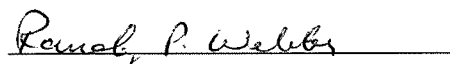
- aa. Motion to approve the purchase of the new Town Line signs (4) made by R. Fick. Unanimous approval.
