Minutes from the 2/27/24 meeting

Meeting was called to order at 3:00pm by Lynn Dumont

Susie Kresina and Alyson Nightingale were voted in as members by unanimous vote.

Review of last month's meeting minutes were approved by Yolanda and seconded by Amy, and approved by all. The treasurer's report showed no changes from last month with the account amount at \$5,418.91, and was approved by Lynn, seconded by Amy and approved by all.

Old Business:

1. Logo for book cover: Danielle showed two examples of coloring pages for the cover of the book. Talked about adding in the Garland Days info on the coloring page itself to give more room for the picture on the front of the book.

New Business:

1. Town Warrant: Talked about an amount we would ask the town for to help with the costs of repair or buying new equipment where it has been so long since a Garland Days was held. Decided on \$1,500, with the motion to approve made by Lynn and seconded by Yolanda, and being approved by all. Lynn will ask for volunteers at the town meeting on March 9th.
2. Corporate donation update: We received two letters declining to donate. Lynn sent out a few new letters to businesses we didn't have on our list.
3. Food trucks/contract: Deb's on Wheels from Carmel has agreed to be there for Garland Days and she does a variety of the classic fair foods. Danielle will make up a contract and get it to her to sign.
4. Update on bouncy house etc.: Lynn will check with the town about insurance needed to cover a bouncy house and will start contacting places to try and put a deposit on one.

5. Volunteers: The post on facebook brought in a few volunteers, the ATV club will do a cornhole tournament, Susie will do the kids race, Alyson is in charge of the kids games and Veronica will have a temporary tattoo booth. Have leads on entertainment, reptiles and maybe milking goats. Will ask the church if they would be willing to do the ice cream sundaes. Lynn is checking with boy scout troops to see about volunteering to run the admissions for Garland Days.
6. Events: Susie thinks she might be able to do flag football. Threw out ideas of a donut eating contest, pumpkin painting, and a sack race. Danielle and Lynn will start the planning for the craft fair that will be held at Garland Days.
7. Ad book: Danielle will write up a new letter and will contact the printer to see what form we need to get businesses info in (pdf, business cards etc). Lynn made a motion to give Wade and Karen Worster a free ad space which was seconded by Yolanda and approved by all.
8. We will see about getting the town to mow the field all summer so it will be nice by the time Garland Days is here. Will start thinking about another fundraiser before Garland Days gets too close.
